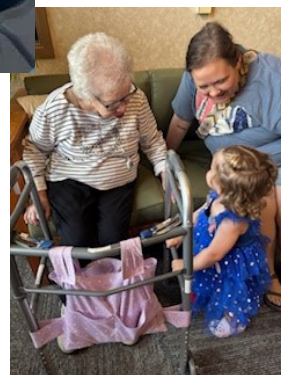
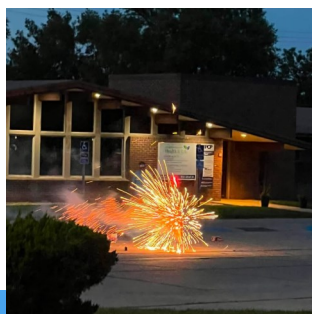

Daughters of the American Revolution brought root beer floats for everyone . Thank You!

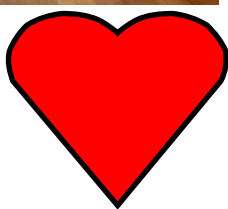

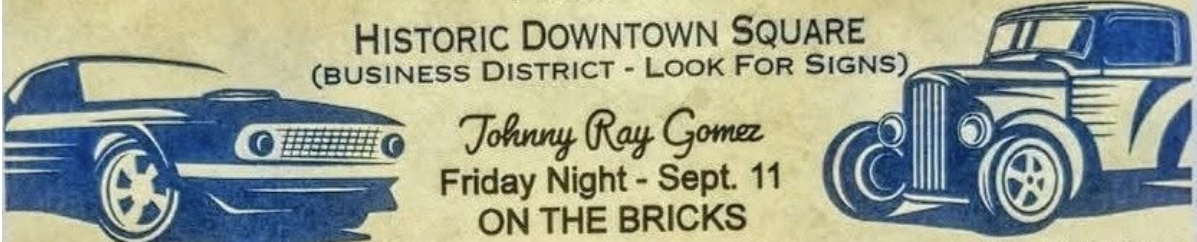

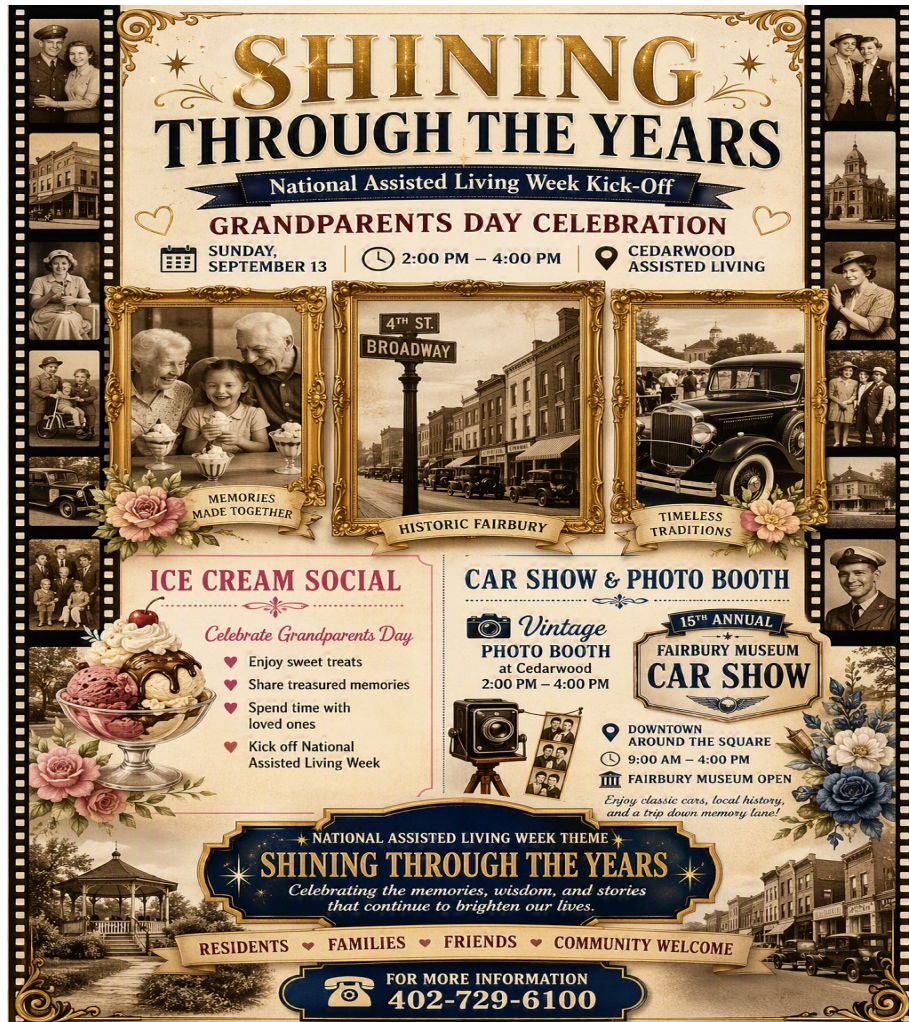
